Nelson House
Saturday 13th
1902

My Dear Jen:

When I arrived here morning I left 1 hour 15 minutes I could hardly walk around. I fixed sleighs + cats etc got the cat away to Indian with the repair for D.6. Mrs Hatty took my temperture it was 103 I went to bed + was portly of my head couldnt get warmer May poss three hot water bottles around me all day + kept taking one sulpheramide every 2 hours. I am up and around today but

but she was always out
& I never found out if
she did or not. I expected
fish returns from Booths
in Winnipeg also some
other mail from Sondack
etc. she might ask Don
if he got any unopened
mail. if so possibly
she could have it sent
back or I may be able
to go to M. L. when I get
going again. wonder if
the Government granted an
extension to M. L. hope so.

well I hope you are all fine
& keeping well. will be
seeing you soon. 36 below
this morning.
